

away triangles on the sides. When the cube is unfolded, it reveals the true cross, which is the vertical form of spirit coming down into the horizontal form of matter. When we look a little further into the four faces of the pyramid form, you get a picture of the four faces of God, signified by the four winds, north, south, west, and east, portrayed by the four faces of Ezekiel's wheel. Again, you have the zodiac: Taurus, the earth element; Leo, the fire element; Scorpio, the water element; and Aquarius, the air element. Each of these faces in turn has a triangular form when the other signs are taken into consideration.

One more thing in conclusion. It deals with the LOGOS. The Logos is one of the supreme mysteries of the Godhead, and it was a mystery word chanted in the mysteries. It concerned four sacred words: Hod, He, Vau, He (J,H,V,H). The first word, Hod, was the active principle, initiative. The second word, He, was the passive principle, inertia. The third word, Vau, was equilibrium, the form. The fourth word, He, was the result of latent energy. Put them all together and you have the mystery of creation explained, and you have the four faces of God: JeHoVaH.
