On July 28, 2015, Robert "Bob" Anthony Scardina, of Novato, California, passed away in his home surrounded by his family after a long courageous battle with Parkinson's.



Born in San Francisco on February 25, 1946,



he grew up in Laurel Heights and graduated from George Washington High School, Class of 1963.



Shortly after, he proudly served his country in the United States Army and was stationed in Germany in the late 1960's.



Upon his return to the states, he began his career with the family grocery business at Laurel Super Market near his childhood home in San Francisco. Frequent shoppers knew Bob as the friendly and outgoing neighbor who cared for and served his customers.

On October 25, 1970, Bob married Margaret Shealor in Jackson, California.



Together they had three children-Craig (Angie), Jamie (Ronelle) and Megan (Matt).



Bob especially loved spending time with his children at home, watching them play sports and boating at Lake Tahoe.

Bob welcomed the loves of his life-his seven grandchildren-Brittney, Julia, Anthony, Joey, Isabella, Lila and Jackson.



He is also survived by his three sisters and their spouses- Gerry Benson (Ron), Diane Hollister (Ray) and Joyce-Scardina Becker (Dana), in laws Robert and Barbara Fary, and many cousins who he had enjoyed over the years here in Marin County.

Bob was preceded in death by his parents Ines and Anthony Scardina.

Outside of the family, he enjoyed being part of Unico, an Italian-American social club who met for dinners and events supporting his Italian heritage and the community within Marin County. He was a faithful fan of all local sports, especially the San Francisco Giants, 49ers, the Golden State Warriors and the Berkeley horse races. He was also passionate about Monday Night bocce ball, his "red hot" mustang, BBQ's, and most of all, being with friends and family.


