Sheldon St. Clair Merchant



1945-2025

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Sheldon St. Clair Merchant. On the morning of March 16, 2025, Shel passed away in his sleep at the Northern Nevada State Veterans Home in Sparks, Nevada. He was 79 years old. Shel was very active in the community of Susanville. Shel's booming laugh, neverending sense of humor, and his drive to help others will be greatly missed by all who knew him. Over the last 40 years, he was District Commander of American Legion District #19, Commander of American Legion Post #204, Commander of the Susanville Veterans of Foreign Wars, Lieutenant with Susanville Volunteer Fire Department and Volunteer FireFighter of the Year in 1991, Volunteer FireFighter with Susan River Fire Department and for the Lassen County Office of Emergency Services, Lassen County Grand Jury Foreman, Third Degree Master Mason, and "Elk of the Year" Elk's Lodge #1487.

He was Scoutmaster for Pack 158 and then Boy Scout Troop 159, Job's Daughters Associate Bethel Guardian, Little League Coach, Lassen Youth Soccer Coach, LHS Football Booster, and substitute teacher at Lassen High School. In particular, his work with the American Legion and the VFW became his passion in his later years. He could often be found at the Legion Hall, quick to share a long story and always eager to teach others the "proper way" to make a Martini.

Born in San Diego, CA on November 14, 1945, Shel grew up in the Richmond District of San Francisco and attended Washington High School. He attended Chico State then transferred to the University of San Francisco where he graduated in 1968. He joined the United States Navy and completed the Officer Candidate School. He was honorably discharged in 1972 after serving a tour on the USS De Haven DD727 in the Tonkin Gulf of Vietnam. He returned to Chico State and completed his teaching credential program.

While at Chico State, Shel met the love of his life, Jeanine Denzler. They were married on February 8, 1975. They moved to Susanville in October, 1975, and eventually had three children, James Merchant, Logan Merchant, and Joanna Merchant (Perry).

Shel wore many hats and carried many jobs, but his passion was always in teaching others, showing them to be adaptive, and to stand up for what was right. He taught in Susanville at Lassen High School and Lassen Community College before taking a teaching position with the California Correctional Center (CCC) in 1979. While at CCC he held multiple positions including Teacher, Librarian, Computer Skills Instructor, Public Information Officer, Interim Fire Chief, and GED Instructor. He was deeply proud of his work with the BLM/CCC Wild Horse Program, but even more proud of his work with the GED Course where he helped inmates gain the skills to be successful upon release from CCC. Upon his retirement from CCC, Shel became the Job Steward for Service Employees International Union (SEIU) Local 1000 to assist California Service Employees in Northern California.

He is survived by his brother, Robert Merchant, his sister Karen Merchant (Lang), his wife Jeanine, sons James and Logan, daughter Joanna, grandsons Jackson and Dylan, and granddaughters Eleanor and Aurora.

Services will be held at Diamond Crest Veterans Cemetery at 10:00 am on Sunday, July 20th. A Masonic Funeral Service will be held at 12:00 (noon) on July 20th at the Susanville Masonic Lodge (84 N. Lassen Street, Susanville) with a reception to follow. All are welcome at either service if you'd like to pay your respects.
