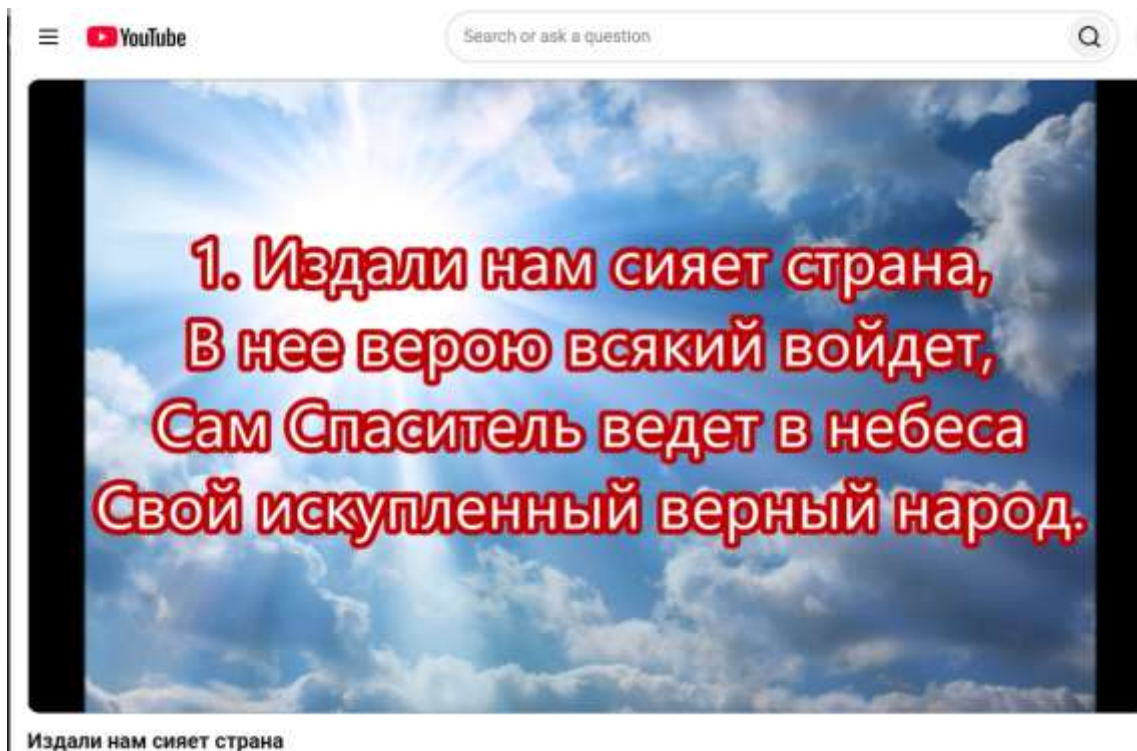

**Chipa** (Spanish pronunciation: [ˈtʃipa], Guaraní pronunciation: [ʃiˈpa]) is a type of small, baked, cheese-flavored roll, a popular snack and breakfast food in [Paraguay](#).<sup>[1]</sup> The recipe has existed since the 18th century and its origins lie with the [Guaraní people](#) of [Asunción](#). It is inexpensive and often sold from [streetside stands](#) and on buses by vendors carrying a large basket with the warm chipa wrapped in a cloth.

The original name is from [Guaraní](#) *chipa*. A small chipa may be called a **chipita**. In [Santa Cruz de la Sierra](#), [Bolivia](#), the term **cuñapé** ([Guaraní](#)) is often used. In some parts of [Argentina](#), it is called **chipá** (with an [accent mark](#)), or **chipacito** when it is small.

### Vocabulary [\[ edit \]](#)

*Chipa* is often baked in smaller doughnuts or buns that may be called *chipita* or *chipacitos*. These are sold in small bags by street sellers of big cities and small towns. In the preparation of chipa yeast is not used, so in spite of the high temperatures of the region it can be preserved for many days. It is a festive food and can be found in every popular religious celebration.<sup>[2]</sup>

## **Eulogy**

**Nida (Nadia – Надежда) Комарчук (Komarchuk)**

**May 25, 1943 - August 3, 2026**

**[acknowledge the immediate family members by name, “sorry for your loss”] (3 sisters left) Olga, Jeannie, and Elsa; 3 sons – Paul, Alex, and Tony; 5 grandchildren – Vicky, David, Daniel, Natalia, and Lily; and 2 great-grandchildren – Solomia and Isaiah.**

**Nida’s son, Paul Komarchuk, asked me to say a few words. Thank you, Paul, for this privilege to honor your mother, and my dearest sister-in-law Nida, whose slavic name Nadezhda (Надежда) means hope.**

**Nadezhda (HOPE) has a beautiful sound and meaning to all of us – for we all hope to see her again -- and other loved ones -- “on the other side.”**

**My wife Elsa, whom Nida talked to a lot about family and life in general almost every week, was very fond of her older sister and valued her advice and “наставление” (constructive instruction) – a word that Nida’s son Paul used to describe his mother’s last words to friends, family, and relatives during her last days on earth.**

**Elsa helped me with this memoriam – or like I love to call it – a celebration of Nida’s life. Elsa told me to keep it short. Elsa’s memories of her sister Nida go back to their early years in Colonia Fram, a humble farm in Paraguay, South America, where the father Onisim had the entire family help him pick cotton to make a living. Nida worked at a doctor’s office later when the family moved to the capital city of Asuncion, where they all waited for their chance to come to America.**

**When the family moved to San Francisco in 1962, they lived together for a year on DeHaro Street on Potrero Hill, then afterwards moved to 22<sup>nd</sup> Street in the Mission District. Nida worked in a sewing factory, working with garments.**

When Gennady Komarchuk (we called him Jim) came a-courting, Nida left the crowded home and began a life with her husband, with whom she had three sons: Paul, Alex, and Tony. Nida was a devoted wife and mother. Through thick and thin, Nida displayed an exemplary virtue of devotion to God and family.

Elsa remembers the years she was baby-sitting Nida's first-born son Paul, whom Elsa enjoyed taking care of while the parents worked. They even took her to Clear Lake and other vacation spots because they knew she would take good care of Pavlushka – that's what Elsa called him. In fact, when Elsa gave birth to our son, she made sure to name him Pavlushka, also. Probably because she had good memories of Paul Komarchuk and loved that endearing name – Pavlushka.

My memories of Nida begin when I married into the large Kowal family and realized that I had basically inherited 7 sisters, with whom I interacted throughout the years, and loved visiting the families as the La Familia grew in size. I called the 7 sisters "the Pleiades" and always looked for that constellation of 7 stars in the heavens, especially when they were visible with the naked eye during winter.

I am going to digress here and talk about Nida's spiritual life. She was a person who loved God and believed deeply in living a godly life. I noticed that her love for God extended to love for people. In fact, when I conversed with her father Onisim, who was a "god-fearing" person like my father, I realized that Nida was more like her mother Evdokia (we called her Baba Eva) because of the humble loving nature that she showed to all her children and grandchildren. My mother Olga was also like that – and she wanted to make sure I put the words "God is Love" on her tombstone because that was her guiding principle in life.

There is a Bible verse that says, "Faith without works is dead." Well, I can testify to the fact that Nida's faith was full of good deeds that she did for family and for others. I remember this one time that Nida was giving bags of tangerines to everybody she knew. My favorite example is the chipas that

she made for us when we visited her in San Mateo and in Folsom. That was a specialty (a special meal) she learned to make in Paraguay. When Nida came to visit us in Oregon one year, she even made chipas for our neighbors, who said, “those are the best chipas in the world.”

I could go on about Nida, how she worked hard cleaning houses with her sister Olga. I should even mention that her caring sister Jeannie visited Nida many times in the hospital and made sure Nida was well taken care of. [6 years ago, Jeannie and Elsa spent hours helping her decide whether to have open heart surgery or not. Doctors gave her little time to live. Thank God she listened to her son and sisters to let her heart decide, and to continue living, depending always on the Lord’s own timetable for her.]

But my favorite sister story is when Nida made sure we all contributed money for Rosie when the youngest sister left us eight years ago, ensuring that Rosie received a proper burial. Natalie and Dina also should be mentioned as sisters with whom Nida had good relationships. Just like she tried to have with all people. “Love one another,” said our Master, and Nida was a true follower of that profound teaching that Christ taught the world.

In conclusion, I would like to tie together three virtues that Nida carried throughout life as the soul qualities of a righteous human being: the Scriptures name them as Faith, Hope and Love (also known as charity). Faith is the substance of Hope, and Love is the reward.

There was a song we sang in Sunday School about these three virtues. It goes like this:

Have Faith, HOPE, and Charity (Love),  
That’s the way to live successfully,  
How do I know?

The Bible tells me so!

Don’t worry about tomorrow  
Just live from day to day,  
The Lord is right beside you,  
He’ll guide you all the Way.

**Have Faith, HOPE, and Charity (Love),

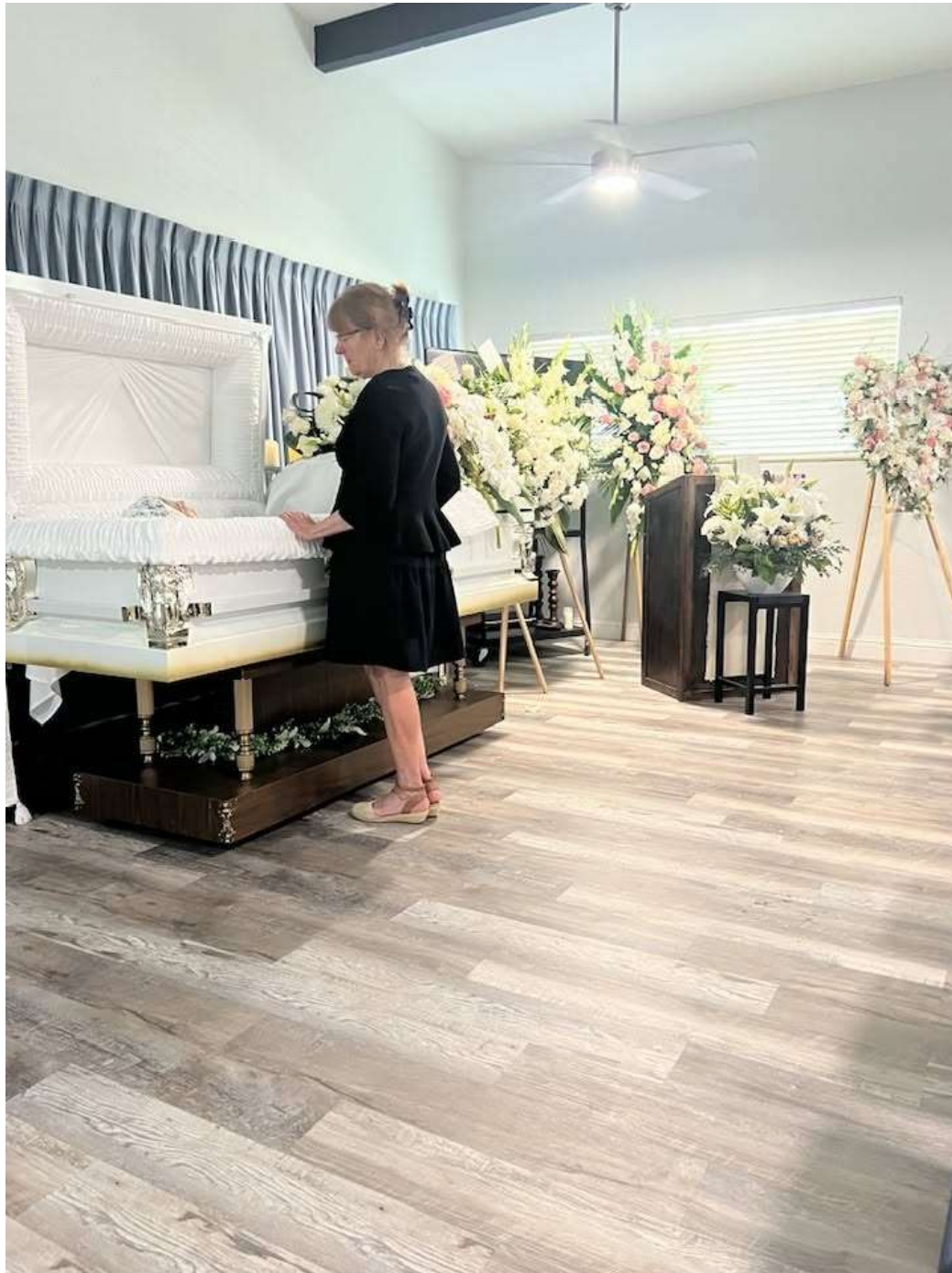
