

*Christus am Ölberge* (in English, *Christ on the Mount of Olives*), Op. 85, is an oratorio by Ludwig van Beethoven portraying the emotional turmoil of Jesus in the garden of Gethsemane prior to his crucifixion. Beethoven's only oratorio, composition consists of six movements - 6. Final chorus (Maestoso – Allegro) „Welten singen“ - „Preiset ihn, ihr Engelschöre“ in C major. The "Welten singen..." finale chorus has enjoyed some popularity on its own, usually being rendered as a "Hallelujah", frequently performed by church, high school, and college choirs.

A German Requiem, to Words of the Holy Scriptures, Op. 45 (German: *Ein deutsches Requiem, nach Worten der heiligen Schrift*) by [Johannes Brahms](#), is a large-scale work for [chorus](#), orchestra, and [soprano](#) and [baritone](#) soloists, composed between 1865 and 1868. It comprises seven [movements](#), In contrast to the traditional Roman Catholic [Requiem Mass](#), which employs a standardized text in [Latin](#), the text is derived from the German [Luther Bible](#). Although the Requiem Mass in the Roman Catholic liturgy begins with prayers for the dead ("Grant them eternal rest, O Lord"), A German Requiem focuses on the living, beginning with the text "Blessed are they that mourn, for they shall be comforted" from the [Beatitudes](#). This theme—transition from anxiety to comfort—recurs in all the following movements except movements IV and VII, the central one and the final one. Almost all movements, with the exception of IV and VII, connect different Bible verses, which lead from suffering and mourning to consolation.

Mass in B minor (German: *h-Moll-Messe*), BWV 232, is an extended setting of the [Mass ordinary](#) by [Johann Sebastian Bach](#). The composition was completed in 1749, the year before the composer's death, and was to a large extent based on earlier work, such as a [Sanctus Bach had composed in 1724](#). Sections that were specifically composed to complete the Mass in the late 1740s include the "[Et incarnatus est](#)" part of the [Credo](#). The Mass in B minor is widely regarded as one of the supreme achievements of [classical music](#). "This monumental work is a synthesis of every stylistic and technical contribution the Cantor of Leipzig made to music. But it is also the most astounding spiritual encounter between the worlds of Catholic glorification and the Lutheran cult of the cross." Butt points out that "only with a musical aesthetic later than Bach's does the concept of parody (adapting existing vocal music to a new text) appear in an unfavorable light" while it was "almost unavoidable" in Bach's day.

Perennially status-conscious and increasingly ground down by the machinations of Leipzig life, Bach spotted an opportunity with the death of the Elector of Saxony in 1733.

Hoping at very least to obtain an honorary title with which to bolster his authority, Bach composed an elaborate 'Missa' (a setting of the Kyrie and Gloria) to present to the new ruler. With its weather eye on the Court's penchant for extravagant Neapolitan-style Mass settings rich in quasi-operatic solo vocal writing, and mindful of the exceptional instrumental forces available, the new work had 'Dresden' written all over it. He perhaps felt that the text of the Mass would remain a timeless anchor forever above the vicissitudes of popular taste. . . choral triptych underscoring the centrality of the Incarnation, Crucifixion and Resurrection.



This chant glorifies the Mother of God, Her liturgical and universal significance. She is likened to the Church and the Paradise, because the

Baby She gave birth to is the Savior of the world.

The lines of this beautiful hymn are reflected in Russian iconography – the first icons titled *All Creation Rejoiceth in Thee* date back to the late 15<sup>th</sup> and early 16<sup>th</sup> centuries. These icons figuratively embody the idea of the unity of the universe: the world above, enclosed in a circular symbol of eternal harmony, and the earthly world at the foot of the mountain.

This scene was very popular later, chiefly due to its universality. The only things that changed were the shape of the temple, the depiction of the paradise trees, the selection of saints, but the harmonious balance between the terrestrial and the celestial remained unaltered, figuratively conveying the central meaning of the chant. More than twenty large *All Creation Rejoiceth in Thee* icons of the 17<sup>th</sup> century and a few smaller ones have survived.



**There is a prayer that was once addressed to our deepest self.** This is a song of mourning for the life that we cannot get hold of, for the self that we cannot truly be. This mourning is the story of our wrestling with life, of our puny self, a self that is elusive, fragile, fearful, and has been plagued with suffering. This self is called, in the Christian tradition, the 'lamb of God', and refers to Jesus as 'Christ'. This self is called a 'lamb' because it is destined to die in the embrace of being. Being is its only reality. American composer Samuel Barber's 'Agnus Dei' is a gorgeous expression of a longing for God, a longing that is the one longing of all humanity, the desire for peace, the unceasing quest for a happy living. The chant is a plea, a plea to the lamb of God, to the one that God has brought on the altar to be slain; the one that has in its hand the key for the release of suffering from the prison of the apparent self. That one can save us, it is said. But who is this one but ourself? And you receive mercy by recognizing your true identity as simply Being.



## Postscript

The “Songs of Joy” theme throughout the repertoire was produced by classical musical sounds from the giants of classical music: Beethoven (from the perspective of Mount Olives) with the jubilant “angelic choirs” singing praises of hallelujah; Brahms (in Ein Deutsches Requiem) bringing the mourner from mortal physical concerns to spiritual heights of “everlasting joy”; Bach (in the B minor Mass) reproducing the incarnation, crucifixion, and shouts of “sanctus” story of our Lord of Hosts; and Wagner (in the Pilgrim’s chorus from Tannhauser) bringing the pilgrim’s journey to a salvific conclusion. Other notable songs: “Hold on”, which reminded the listener to hold on to the gospel plow (of the Kingdom of Heaven); “Agnus Dei”, a song of mourning and a gorgeous expression of a longing for divine intercession and peace; Chesnokov’s church Slavonic hymns of devotion to the Mother of God in “O Tebe Raduyetsa” and to “Salvation” provided throughout the earth from the beginning of ages; and “Be Still My Soul”, a song which brings the singer to a contemplative and “joyful end.”
